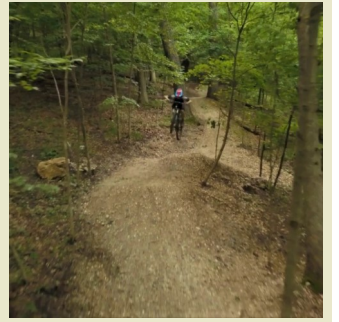

### How are your membership dues & donations spent?

- Approximately \$10K is raised per year in membership dues. Those dues, in conjunction with fundraising, allow us to provide premier trails to the area!

### What does Fundraising include?

- Events, One-time large contributors and annual sponsors. As well as ongoing fiscal support from the City of Asbury and the Dubuque County Conservation. Additionally, local programs contribute like John Deere Dollars for Doers (volunteer time cash match)

We rely on volunteers from the community to keep trails in prime condition!

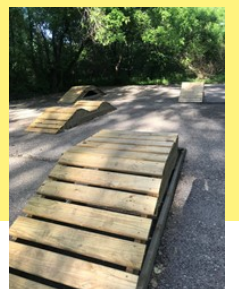
### TMBR is a 100% volunteer organization with no wages paid

- After the notable costs to have trails professionally built, remaining funds are utilized for administrative expenses & trail maintenance.
- Maintenance costs include a contracted mower, and a shed full of tools for volunteer efforts.
- Each trail system has a designated Trail Steward that monitors conditions daily to determine if trails are rideable and ensures trails are maintained. Status updates are provided via the TrailForks website & fed directly to [tmbtrails.org](http://tmbtrails.org)

# projects



- Cloie Creek (2.5 miles) Complete Spring 2017 @ 43K Cost – 100% Fundraised
- Interstate Power Preserve (6.5 miles) Complete Oct 2019 @ \$167K Cost – 100% Fundraised
- Proving Grounds trail-building is a work in progress by Pathfinders Trail Builders LLC
  - 5 miles of trails are currently rideable, with a total of 7+ miles estimated for completion by YE
  - This park was a joint project, with John Deere & Dubuque County. TMBR has led the trail development portion and raised \$270K of the total park estimated costs of over \$500K
  - Eagle Scout Daniel Reich contributed 6 wooden features for a PG skills area
